Crowville United Methodist Church Scholarship

Scholarship Program criteria:

- Undergraduate, full-time students
- Resident of Franklin Parish
- Students classified as beginning Freshman
- Student must study at an accredited university, junior college, or community college
- Based on financial need, academic success, community involvement, and application content
- Members of the Crowville Methodist Church will receive preference in awarding the CUMC Scholarship

Scholarship specifics:

- Awarded for one academic year
- Annual award is \$500.
- Applicants for Freshmen level scholarship must have a 2.50 cumulative GPA for high school on a 4.0 grading scale
- Scholarship funds may be used for tuition and other related educational expenses as approved by the scholarship committee
- Scholarship funds will be remitted to scholarship recipient to apply toward education expenses upon registration. Proof of registration must be submitted to Scholarship Committee.

Other Information:

- Applicant must submit two letters of reference (non-family members)
- GPA can be confirmed using official transcript or school website if it is unaltered and has school's URL visible on page
- Scholarship application must be received by March 1 of award year
- Special circumstances can allow for acceptance of application from those with a lower GPA or GED.
- Return application to CUMC, Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 30, Crowville, LA 71230
- Top applicants may be interviewed.
